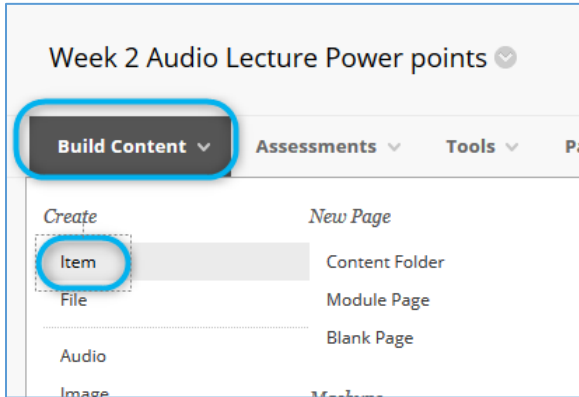


# Embedding a YouTube video in Blackboard

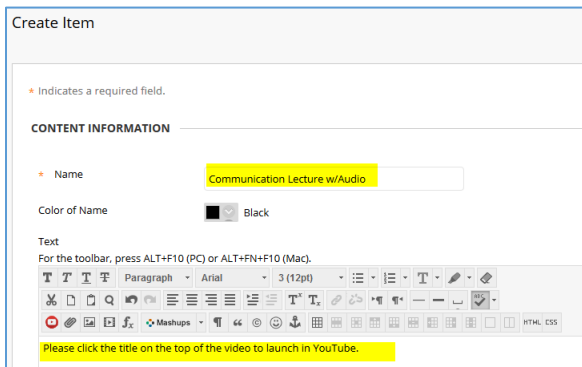
Open the course where the video will reside. Navigate to the location for the video.

## Directions:

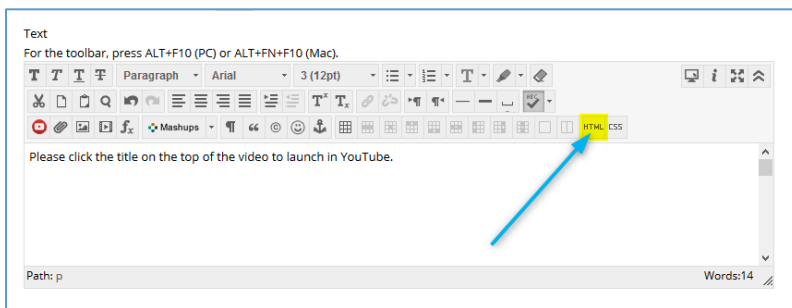
1. Choose **Build Content** at the top of the screen, **Item**:



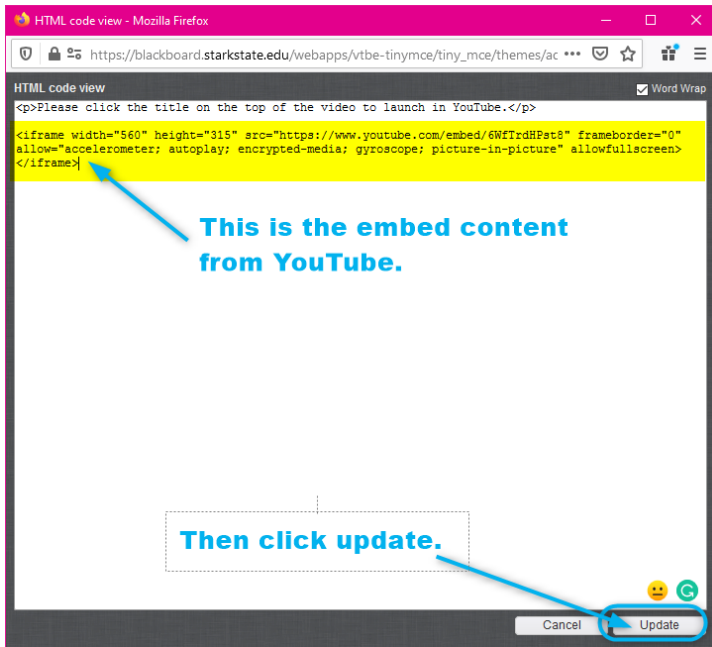
2. Add a Name for the file and any instructions (see highlights).



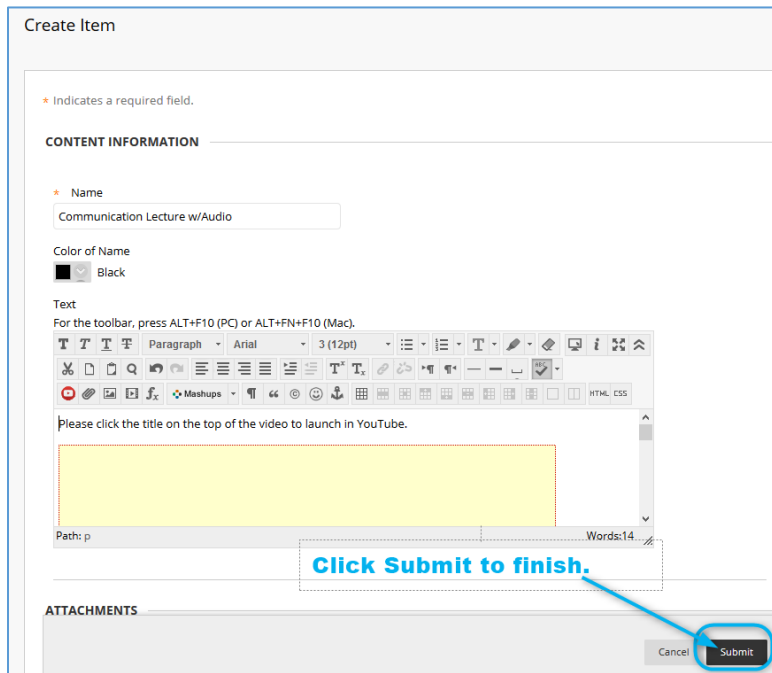
3. Next, click the HTML link on the toolbar:



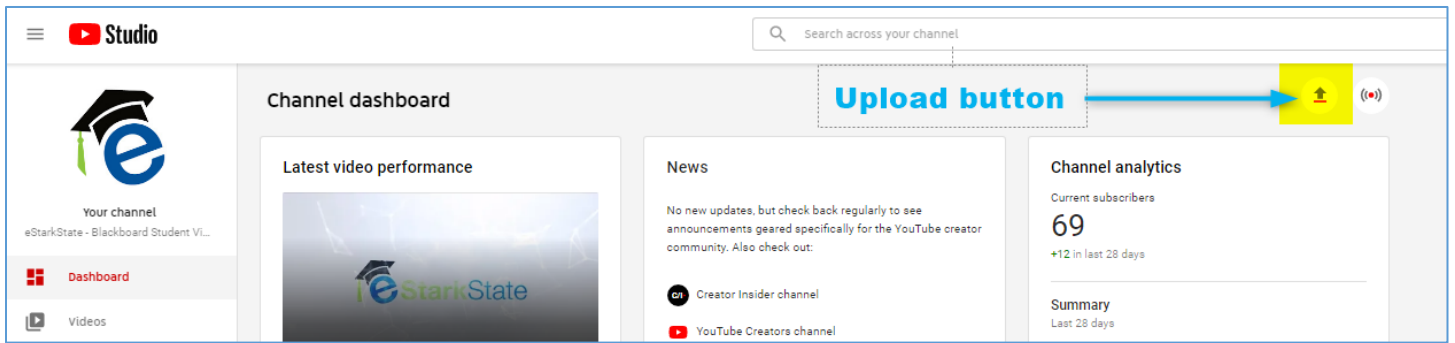
4. Paste in the window the **embed** content copied from YouTube. Then click the **Update** button.



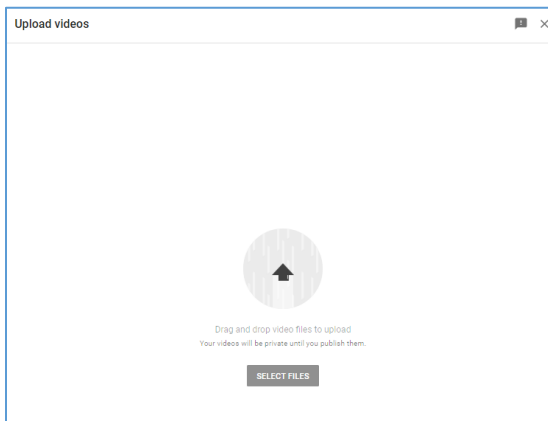
5. Click **Submit** to finish.



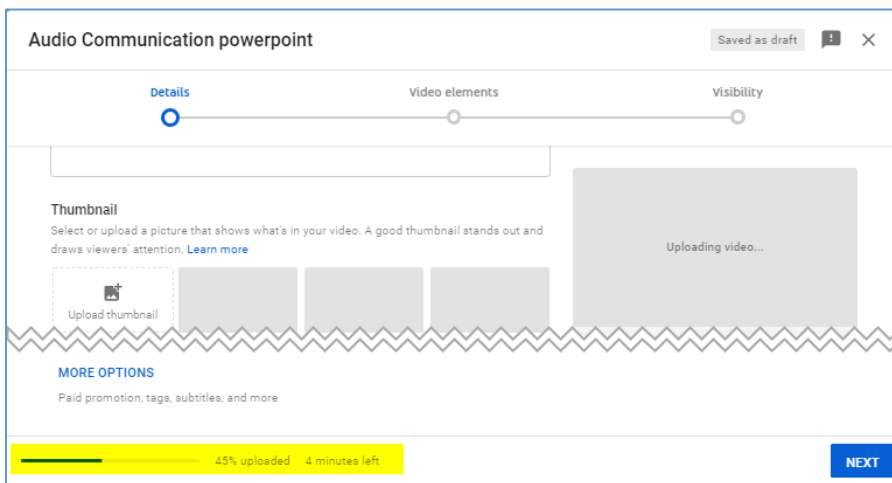
6. Click the upload button.



7. Choose and upload the file.

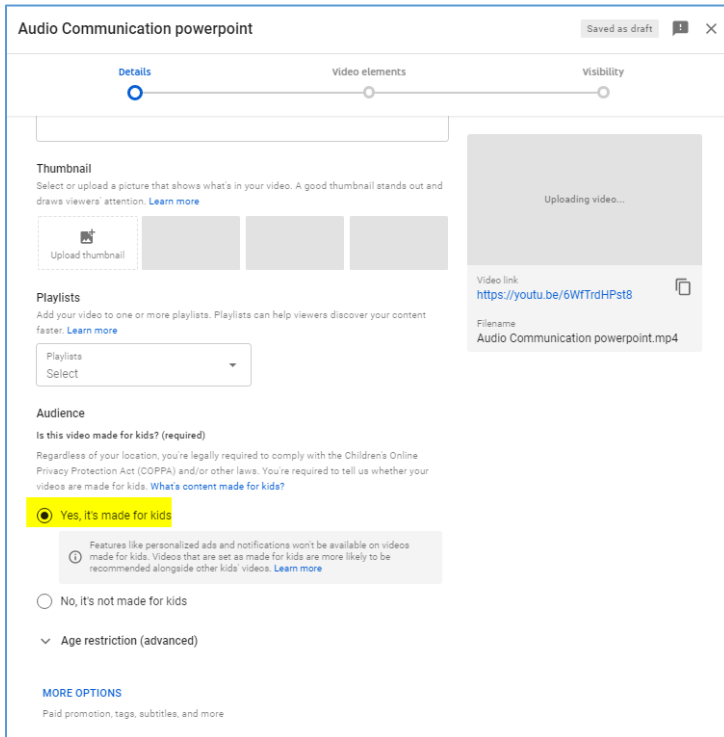


8. Next, more waiting as the file is uploaded to YouTube.

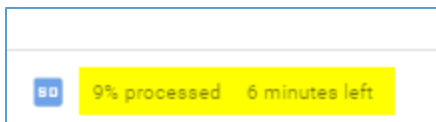


At this time, review the settings for the video:

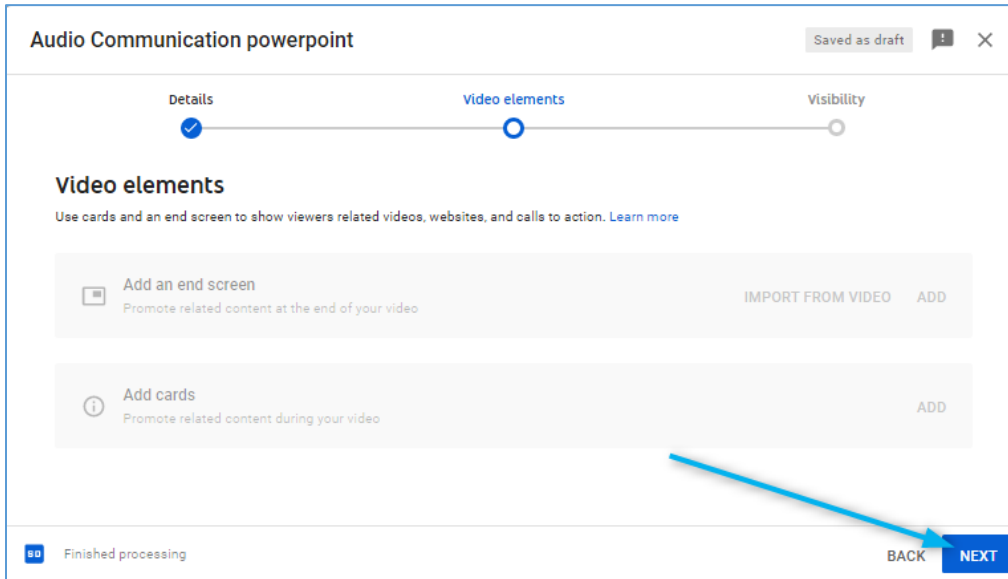
Choose the **“Yes, it’s made for kids”** option.



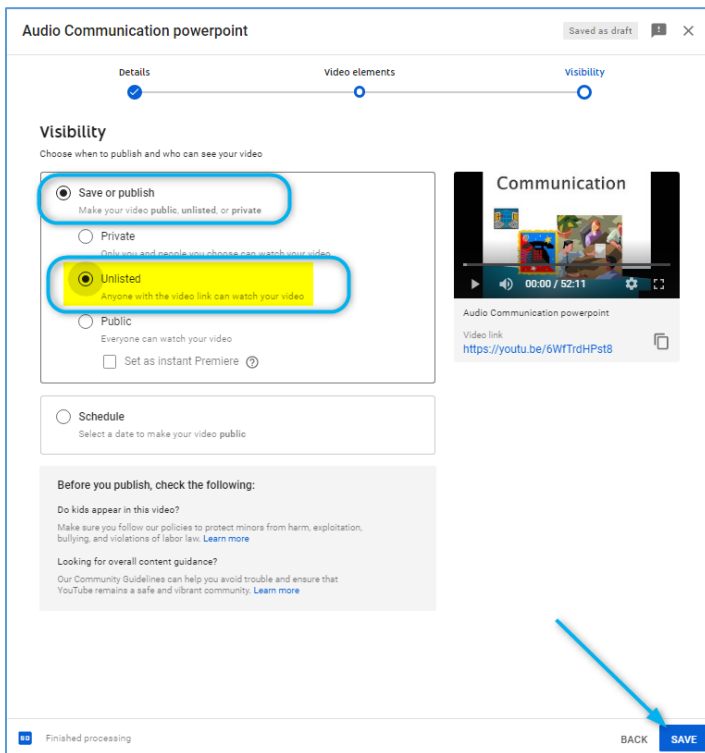
9. Once the video is uploaded, it has to be processed. Again, these steps can take a while. Keep your eye on the progress indicator!



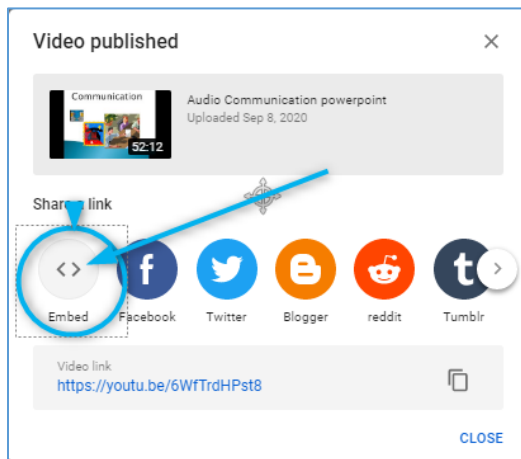
10. Once the video is processed, click **Next**. There's nothing to change on this page, so, click **Next** again.



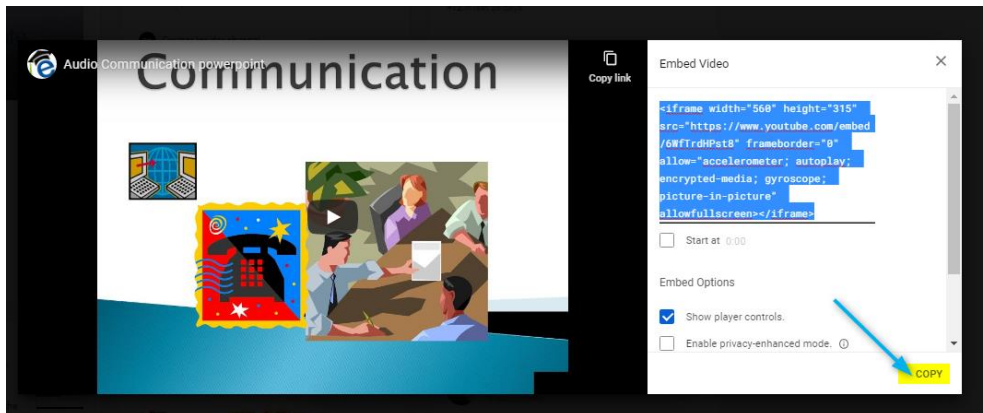
11. On the final screen, be sure to choose **Unlisted**, for the Visibility choice. The choose **Save**.



12. Click the **Embed** button to



13. Click the **Copy** link on the embed video page.
