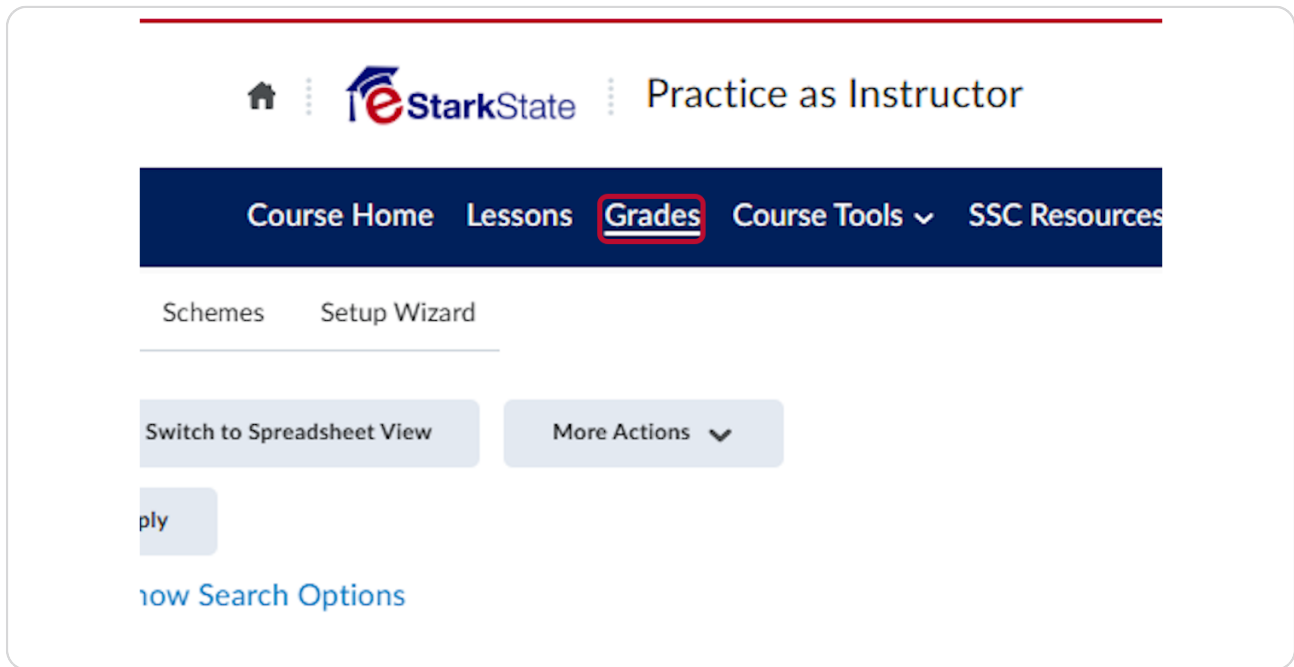


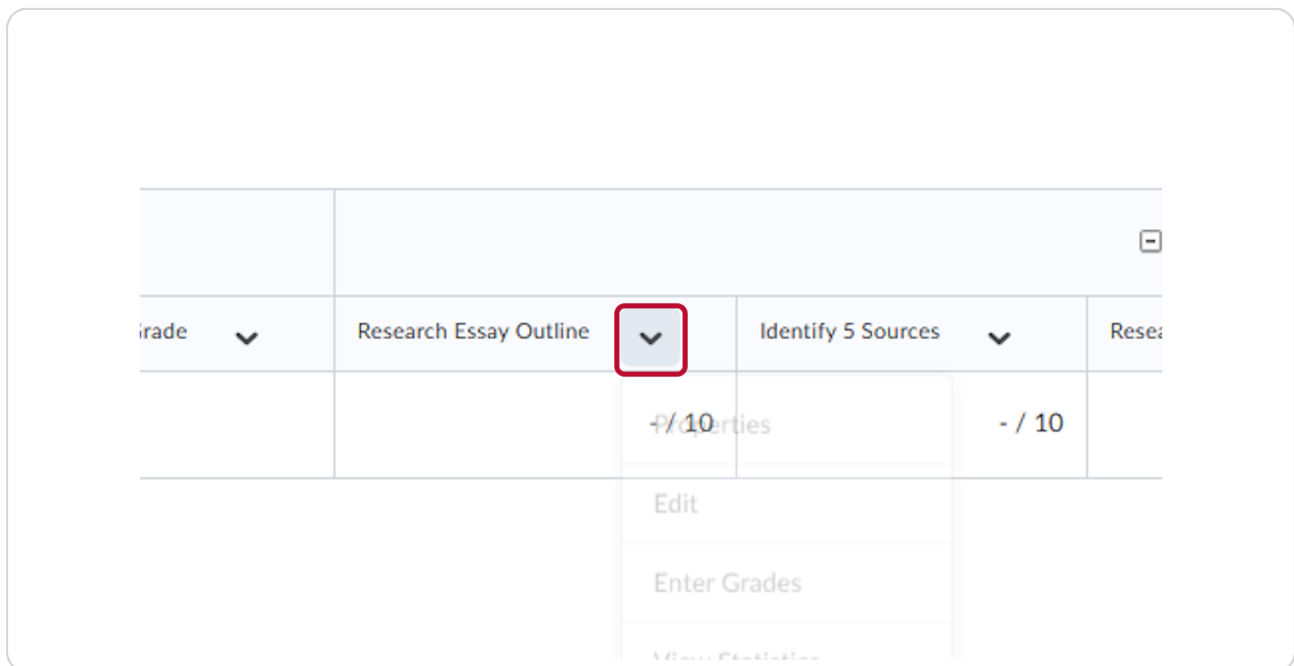

Click on Grades



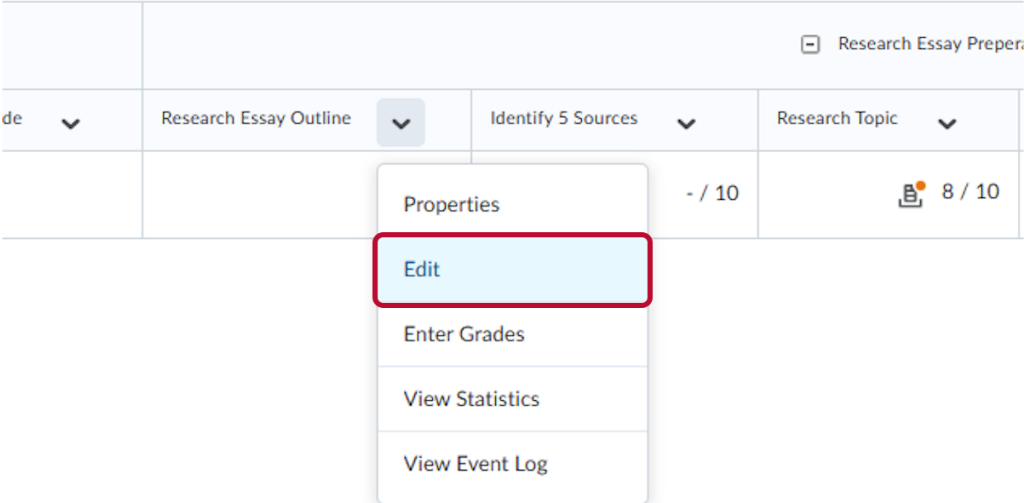
STEP 2

Click on Edit



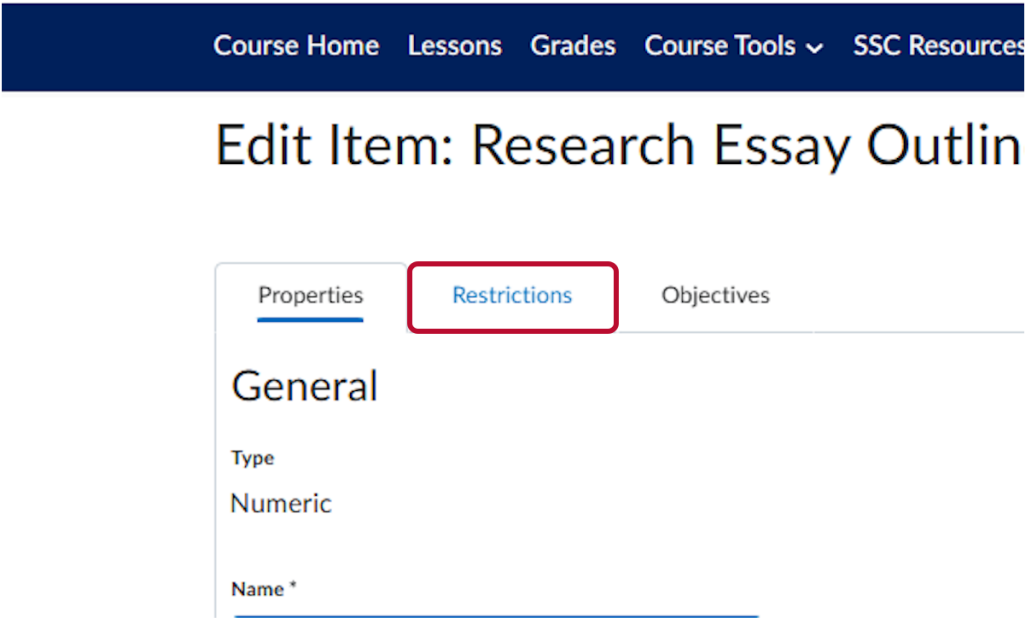
